CONFLICT MINERAL POLICY

This policy is made as an attempt to support conflict free supply chain.

According to section 1502 of US Dodd Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (July 21st, 2010) which define conflict free mineral and metal as tantalum, tin, gold, tungsten and their derivatives such that they directly or indirectly finance or benefit illegal armed groups through mining or mineral trading in Democratic Republic of Congo and it's adjoining countries.

Our company, PT. Sariwiguna Binasentosa is a tin smelter and refinery who produce high quality tin ingot under the brand "SBS" shares the worldwide concern regarding to conflict free mineral and metal and fully support EICC and GeSI who have been working to provide transparency and accountability concerning to the supply of raw materials coming from the conflict zones of the Democratic Republic of Congo.

It is our policy to procure locally tin concentrates which is 100% come from domestic source in Indonesia and committed to never use nor processed any materials that originating from conflict areas. Therefore SBS's product is categorized conflict free.

PT. Sariwiguna Binasentosa encourage all organizations involved in tin mining, manufacturing or the use of tin products to join us in keeping conflict minerals out of our supply chain.
